for Dual Credit Enrollment

Dual credit enrollment provides the opportunity for high school students to earn college credit while satisfying high school graduation requirements.

WALLACE HIGH SCHOOL QUALIFICATIONS FOR DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT:

1. Students must be **at least 16 years of age** and/or have completed one-half of the high school graduation requirements.
2. A cumulative **3.0 High School GPA** is required for enrollment. Additional college or university entrance placement may also be required to enroll.
3. Upon enrollment, a college study or transition course must be completed prior to further enrollment.
4. For continued enrollment, a cumulative 2.0 Dual Credit GPA and a 3.0 High School GPA must be maintained.
5. If the Dual Credit class is dropped for any reason, WHS will place the student in a WHS elective class.

Counselor/Principal Approval: All dual credit enrollments are subject to the approval of the principal and counselor.
